## GOD'S CALENDAR OR MAN'S PAGAN CALENDAR

Numbers 9:1-4 - How important? (1 Corinthians [11:27-28](#)) - The Warning

Ex 13:3 (3-7), Gen. [9:15](#) - Bring to mind, an intellectual remembering

Ex [12:14](#), Lev [23:24](#) - a remembrance, reminder, with the implication of celebration, worship, honor

Lev 20:7-8 - sanctify yourselves - set apart make holy

1 Peter [1:22](#) - purified yourselves - to cleanse from defilement (1 Jn:3:3, Ja 4:8)

Isa 59:1-4 - "have separated" to sever (lev [20:22-26](#) [24,26])

2 Cor. [6:14](#) - 7:2 - "heavy ear" - failing/ dull (Isa. 6:8-13)

1 Cor 5:6-8 "more than food items" \*sarpis - ceremony or ritual had replaced righteous

Gregorian calendar was a reform in 1582 by pope Gregory 13th of the Julian Calendar of Julius Caesar in 46 BC after the Roman conquest of Egypt.

Saturday - dies Saturni - Saturn's Day

Sunday - dies solis- Sun's day

Monday - "dies Lunae - moon's day

Etc

Days of the week named after planetary Gods

Sunday became the first day because of its popularity

Monday became the second day - 2nd most popular etc

Evidence of a dead or dying soul - when reading the word of God they receive no "Peace /comfort" neither do they "Fear and Tremble"
