Laodicea - (Peoples) - Self-Willed Church - A wealthy city filled with culture and learning.

Rev. 3:14

“Having a form of godliness, but denying the Power” - 2Tim3:5
Where sinners keep on sinning and never change

Ecc.1:9-10, 3:15, Ezk. 12:11 - Past is the Present
Hosea 12:6(8)-14:9 - Past is the Present

VS.6) - (1) - Turn to Jehovah, (2) Lie Righteously, (3) Daily Trust Him

VS.7) - Hebrew word for merchant/ Canaanite - Same - Ephraim/Canaaite - Gods eyes same

VS.8) - Ephraim was full of Pride, Hardness of Heart, and dependance on self. - They looked at financial prosperity (blessings) as the favor of God. - Rev. 3:17 - “You Say”

(1) “Wretched” - [Miserable-Distressed] down hearted, dismal -(No Power in their answers)

- Suffering from anxiety, sorrow, pain (behind closed doors)

(2) “Miserable” - Pitiabale - deserving of pity

(3) “Poor” - Beggarly - poverty stricken spiritually, (powerless to enrich)

(4) “Blind” - Sightless - (lacking perception, awareness, or discernment)

(5) “Naked” - “unadorned” - (without covering) 5 items only GRACE can overcome

VS.9) - Yet future - Kingdom Age

VS.10) - (1) “Have Spoken”, (2) “Have multiplied” (3) “Have used”

-Wife- “of whoredom or idolatry”/ Son-Tezreel - “God will scatter or Sow”

-Daughter - “Lo-ruhamah” - not pitied or spared

-Son- “Lo-Ammi” - Not My People - Mt.25:12/Ezk33:11-13/Ezk.18:23-26
